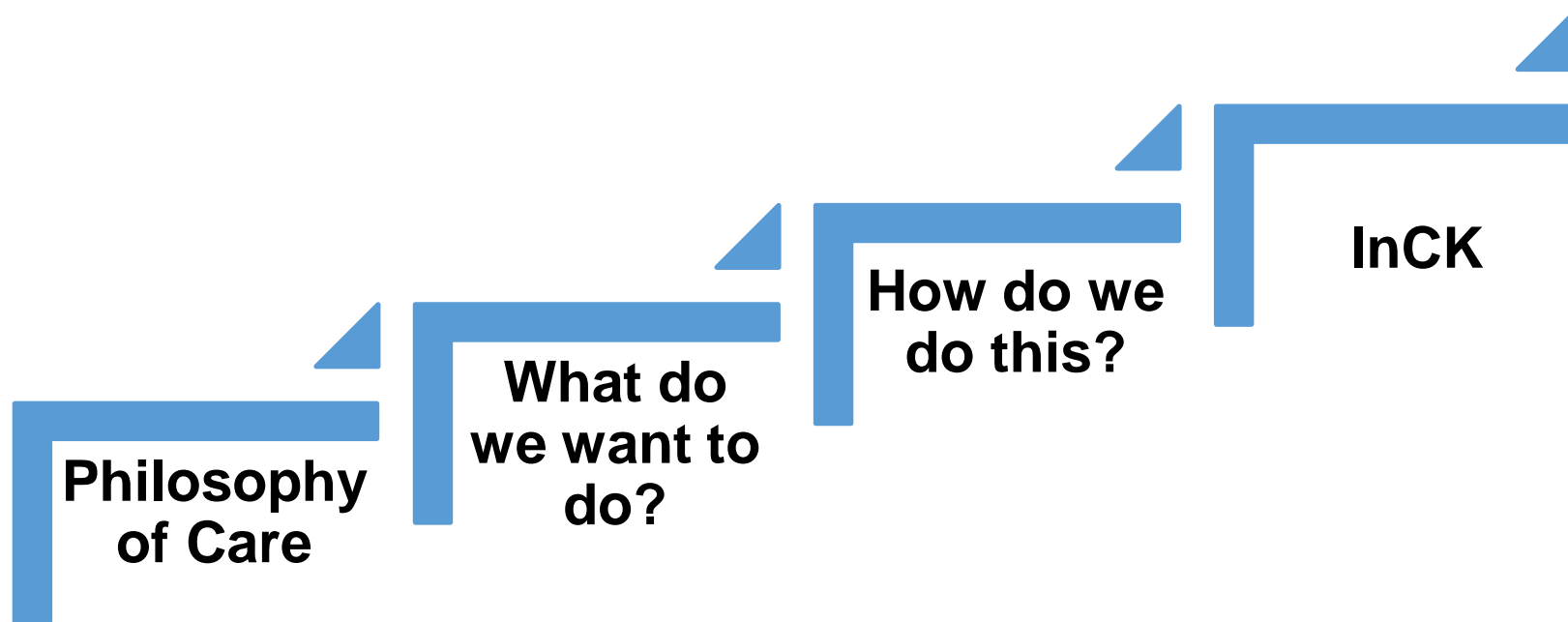

Charge

- Integrate health care provider community with Care Coordination services/performance improvement

Tasks

- Establish provider Criteria and Terms & Conditions for performance-based reimbursement
- Streamline eligibility & enrollment measures and/or processes
- Ensure seamless care coordination services across Core Child Services
- Instill Business associate agreements (BAAs), Data Use Agreements (DUAs) and authorization/consent
- Deploy publicly-facing technologies
