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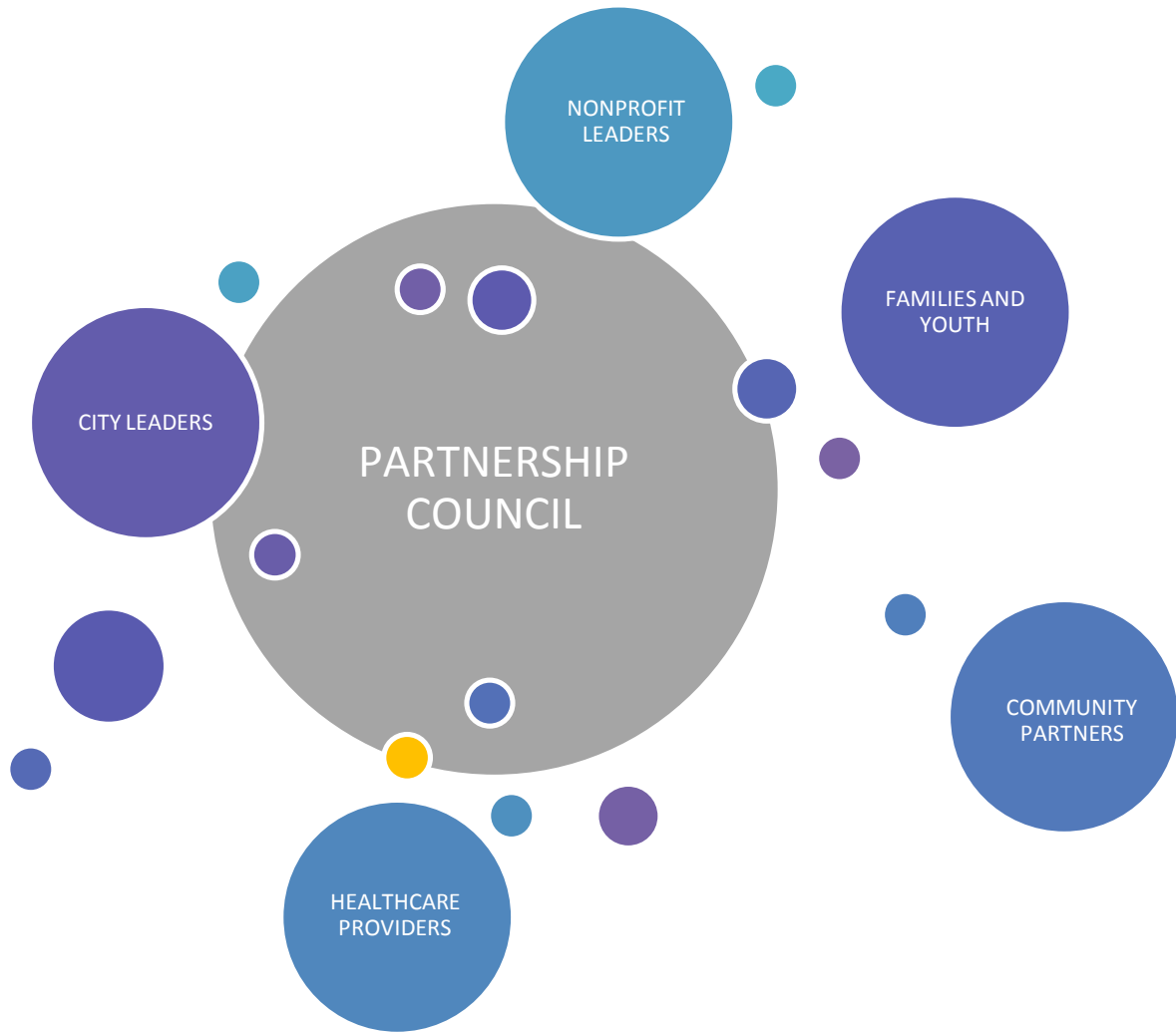

Goal

- Identify streamlined eligibility and enrollment measures and/or systems for cohorts of InCK target population
- Advise on terms and conditions for InCK Providers
- Develop processes for managing care coordination services across Core Child Services
- Recommend approaches to executing business associate agreements (BAAs), Data Use Agreements (DUAs) and advise on processes and authorization/consent forms for model participation with InCK Providers
- Identify continuous quality improvement processes to support model efficacy
- Support and advise on the functional deployment of publically-facing technologies

Stratification/Needs Assessment

Purpose

- Advise provide feedback on goals and provide high-level recommendations on needs assessment and stratification

Goal

- Identify Needs Assessment tool(s) to assess needs of target population
- Determine the who, how, when, where the needs assessment will be administered
- Devise Stratification processes and protocols to determine Service Level Integration (SIL) eligibility
- Pilot Needs Assessment with community providers
- Identify administrative sources of data required for needs assessment

Alternative Payment Model (APM)

- Identify how the non-federal portion of payments will be funded;
- Advise on performance measure tied to payment and how they will be developed;
- Advise on the terms and conditions of InCK providers
- Identify how Population-Based Payments will be developed and what data and sources of data will be used;
- Identify how quality of care will be measured and the APMs will be evaluated.
