

A STORY ABOUT JORGE

Jorge came to us having been diagnosed with an intellectual/developmental disability (IDD) and was living in a supervised home in the community. He had fallen into selling drugs, carrying a loaded gun, and other behaviors that concerned us and the on-site clinicians of his community home. After engaging through therapy at CBCCC, Jorge got rid of his gun and moved into a group home that he says is a more positive environment. Due to the work we did with Jorge and the work he did on himself, he is now significantly less aggressive, a better self advocate, has better hygiene, takes his medication regularly, and even keeps his room clean on a regular basis. Says Jorge, "I am in a better place than I was and I'm a better guy than I was and I thank you for steering me in the right direction."
